Item 1	Competition Venue	
	The venue for the Rosalie Premier League is:	
	Rosalie Park, Onslow Road, Shenton Park	
	Car parks can be accessed from Onslow Road and Derby Road.	
Item 2	Team Eligibility	
	 To be eligible, teams must: Nominate by Friday September 21, 2002. Pay registration fee by Friday October 7, 2022. Provide playing shirt design by Friday October 7, 2022. Register players by Friday October 14, 2022. 	
Item 3	Player Eligibility	
	 To be eligible, players must: Register by Friday October 14, 2022 for Round 1. By 12:00PM on the Tuesday prior to the fixtured round the player will commence playing. 	
	A player may only play in one team in one division.	
	A player may play in more than one division (ie. women's and mixed; men's and mixed).	
	Any player serving a suspension at Affiliate level during the dates of the Rosalie Premier League is ineligible to participate for the duration of that suspension.	
Item 4	Coach Eligibility	
	Not applicable.	
Item 5	Divisions	
	Men's Open Women's Open Mixed Open	
	Each division is currently limited to 6 teams only so early registration is recommended. A wait list will be kept, and Team Contacts advised should additional teams be able to be accommodated.	
	A player who is younger than 18 years of age is considered a child and therefore a 'Duty of Care' is placed upon all teams in selecting and playing of younger aged players. All other player eligibility rules apply.	
	Male players can only be nominated for male divisions.	
	Female players can only be nominated for female divisions.	
	Both male and female players can be nominated for divisions in accordance with the 8th edition of the TFA Playing Rules.	
	 Note: A division must have a minimum of four teams to make the division active. 	
	 If sufficient team numbers have nominated for the division at the close of nominations, however, teams pull out after this time, wherever possible, Rosalie Touch Association will endeavour to continue this division in a modified version. 	
Item 6	Team Nomination Process	
	Teams must submit their official Team Nomination Form by 5:00PM Friday September 21, 2022 to: <u>administrator@rosalietouch.com.au</u> .	
	The form must contain the contact details for the Team Contact including:

	Team Contacts have the implied delegated authority of their team. Team Contacts may also list the details of Team Managers. Information may be passed onto these individuals as required to assist in the flow of information to participants.
Item 7	Medical Assistance
	Teams are required to supply their own medical staff for the treatment of minor injuries. It is the team's responsibility to ensure that their medical staff possess adequate qualifications and insurances (minimum level 1 sports trainer).
	Rosalie Touch Association will ensure that suitably trained first aid staff are available for diagnosis of all serious injuries.
	Rosalie Touch Association will contact the Team Contact during the event for medical issues involving the respective team.
Item 8	Referee Nomination Process
	It is not expected that teams will be required to provide a referee for any games throughout the competition. Team Contacts will be advised if this changes.
Item 9	Team Registration Fees
	Team registration fee is \$1,500 (GST inclusive).
	The team registration fee is due by 5:00PM Friday October 7, 2022.
	Draws will only be confirmed when all fees have been paid.
	Team registration fees that are late will be treated as a late entry and will incur a late payment fee as indicated in Item 11.
Item 10	Insurance
	The TFA Accident Insurance Scheme covers eligible players (Item 3) in eligible teams (Item 2).
Item 11	Late Entries
	Team Nomination Forms received after the relevant closing date will only be accepted at the convenience of the competition (ie. to replace a bye or another withdrawal) and will incur a late payment fee of \$100 (GST exclusive).
Item 12	Refunds
	No refunds will be provided to any team that withdraws after the close of nominations.
	A full refund will apply to teams that are not able to play due to insufficient number of teams nominating to make a division active. This will be determined two weeks after the close of nominations.
Item 13	Player Registration Process
	It is the responsibility of each Team Contact to ensure that all the team's players meet the eligibility criteria of the competition.
	 Teams are encouraged to nominate sufficient players to allow for injuries and absence throughout the competition. Teams may register: Maximum of 20 players per team. Minimum of ten players per team.
	A minimum of ten players must be registered by Friday October 14, 2022, otherwise the team may be withdrawn.

	October 17, 2022. This is the opportunity to make any changes prior to the first round. These changes are to be hand-written legibly on the report. Once the Team Contact is satisfied with the document, they are to sign off on its accuracy.
	Any deletions, additions, replacements or number changes will be permitted but must be submitted in writing by the Team Contact no later than 12:00PM on the Tuesday prior to the fixtured round the change will affect.
	No deletions, additions, replacements or number changes will be permitted after 12:00PM Wednesday January 11, 2023 (ie. prior to Round 9).
	Any changes to playing numbers after this time will result in a \$20 (GST exclusive) fine per offence and must be submitted by the Team Contact.
	Playing of unregistered or ineligible players will result in a \$200 fine (GST exclusive) and/or forfeit of the match.
	Rosalie Touch Association must be made aware of changes or issues as soon as possible. This however does not exclude application of the fine.
	Players must play in a minimum of five (5) round games to be eligible for finals.
Item 14	Player Pool and Timelines

Item 16	Tents and Associated Equipment

Item 17	Uniforms
	All playing uniforms must include:
	 A numbered shirt, singlet, bodysuit or two-piece suit (no temporary measures such as tape will be permitted to replace numbers).
	 A 1 or 2-digit number which meets the requirements of the TDA rules of the game. No 3-digit numbers will be permitted.
	 0 can only be used in the following numbers: 0, 10, 20, 30, 40, 50. Shorts or bike pants.
	 Footwear which meets the requirements of the TFA rules of the game.
	 Socks (that are visible).
	The only playing numbers permissible are between 0 and 50. No numbers outside that range will be permitted.
	Only approved playing unforms will be permissible for players to wear while they are involved in any game during the competition.
	No predominantly white playing uniforms will be permitted.
	All current uniform designs are to be forwarded to: <u>administrator@rosalietouch.com.au</u> by 5:00PM Friday October 7, 2022 to ensure that no obvious uniform clashes occur.
	Any player who is not playing in the official uniform will not be permitted to take the field of play until correctly attired. Referees will endeavour to enforce this rule, however if a breach is proven to have occurred it will result in a caution and fine as deemed appropriate by Rosalie Touch Association.
